"Las Vegas Mountaineers 50 Classic Peaks"

When Joel moved to Nevada around 30 years ago, he joined the Las Vegas Mountaineers Club (LVMC), and started climbing the group's 50 Classic Peaks list, finishing it for the first time in 2010. He's also been very active with the club (which he joined in 1999), taking on various roles over the years, including leading a trip most weekends. Joel's Peakbagger page states "I love climbing peaks and crossing them off a list". He's completed all the county highpoints of Nevada, Utah, and Arizona, the California 14ers, all but 2 of the US State highpoints, a good number of the 4K and 5K prominence peaks in the lower 48 and has but one peak left to complete the DPS list!

The Las Vegas Mountaineers 50 Classic Peaks list was initially put together by Richard Baugh and Mike Harris in the 1990s. Although the majority of peaks are in Nevada, a few are in Arizona, Utah and California (including Whitney, Williamson, White Mtn, Langley and Montgomery). A total of 17 peaks are also on the DPS list. Many of Nevada's finest summits are on the list, including 3 iconic peaks in the Red Rock Canyon (Mt Wilson, Rainbow Wall and Bridge Mtn), with its colorful sandstone rock tinted red and orange by oxidized iron. Another third of the peaks are in Central Nevada primarily in the Snake and Toiyabe Ranges, many of which remain green and snow covered a good part of the year.
